Honorable Mayor and City Council Members,

I am writing you concerning two separate requests for YOUR approved legislation.

Firstly – A-7 APPROVAL OF AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO PAVEMENT MANAGEMENT PROJECT CONTRACT NO. MB-2017-ST01; (PUBLIC WORKS), that should YOU/Council approve this recommendation of approval to Amendment No. 1, in the amount of \$808,395.31, as an additional option period to the City Council awarded Indefinite Delivery, Indefinite Quantity (IDIQ) contract with Pavement Coatings Co.; and/or YOU/Council authorize a 5-percent contingency for the project in the amount of \$40,419.77 to be used to account for differences in material quantities; and/or YOU/Council authorize the Public Works Director to execute requisite contract documents, that YOU/Council require/mandate Public Works to provide written accounting for this any and all spending as they do so for said project. Not just the projected costs itemized in the Amendments. And, that should monies not be spent according to projected report (A-7), that monies be returned to the General Fund.

Secondly – As a concerned and informed member of our citizenship of Morro Bay, that YOU/Council provide Mr. Patrick Sparks, also a citizen who his requested from YOU presentation time to offer a viable and cost effective new waste water treatment plant for one of the original and approved site locations. Please, honor this his requested audience.
